December 30th, The NH Flying Tigers Annual club Christmas Party, 7:00 PM at the Derry West Side

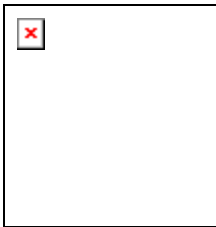
Community Center. Food will be supplied by the club, Be there. This year's gift giving will be a little more dynamic!! Details coming up.

98 Training Season

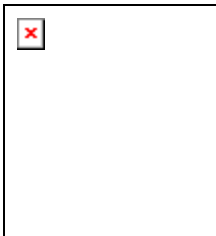
