What's Happening

The July Meeting was called to order at 6:59 with 17 members and guests present.

Old Business:

Treasurers report was read and accepted.

The Secretary's report was read and unanimously accepted.

New Business:

The club picnic is scheduled for August 29th. We have a tentative agreement from an IMAC flyer just North of Albany NY to attend and make several demonstration flights. The secretary made a motion that the club should show it appreciation of the 2 1/2 hours plus this person is going to drive to join us by offering to pay for gas and some expenses. The following motion was made at the meeting:

Motion: To allocate \$50 to give to the IMAC flyer from NY to cover his expenses as he sees fit. This motion will be voted on at the August 25th meeting.

The secretary will extend the offer to the IMAC flyer prior to club approval since everyone at the meeting felt this was a good will gesture.

Vice President John Clark has resigned from office due to a very heavy work schedule this summer. John felt he could not adequately perform his duties as VP. Jerry Lavoie was appointed to the position of Vice President to serve out the remainder of John Clark's elected term in office.

The next club sponsored fun fly was brought up for discussion. The goal is to have the same events as the first contest but to open the competition up to other clubs in the area. The date selected for the fun fly would be determined by the fun-fly committee (Paul Pazolt, Jerry Lavoie, Ed Burie, Mario Natolo, Dave Annicelli, and John Marien). A vote was taken to allocate \$600 for the fun fly to cover food, prizes, advertising and miscellaneous materials. The vote passed 14 in favor and 1 opposed.

Rich Bono questioned the last month's newsletter where it was stated that there was no Secretary's report from the prior month about the keeping of the minutes from that meeting. Though there was no Secretary's report, the minutes were recorded in the form of the Newsletter by the Newsletter editor, Keith Spaulding. A record of the meeting does exist.
