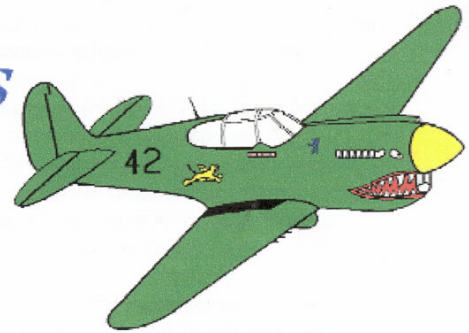

This was voted on and passed with 23 in favor and one abstained.

It was suggested that if the club could raise 1500.00 per year that the dues could be lowered to current levels.
